What is PALS ?

Being in hospital can be a daunting experience and sometimes it can be difficult to speak up, have your voice heard about what matters to you, or discuss any issues you are concerned about.

People's Advocate Liaison Service 'PALS' is a free volunteer advocate service to assist you and your family when you are here at Kooweerup Regional Health Service

Your independent advocate is someone who is by your side when you want support. Their motivation and focus is you.

An advocate can help you navigate the health care system, including discussions with staff and conveying any concerns. They can translate, coordinate, negotiate, monitor and intercede on your behalf.

They will work directly with you, your family or carer so that you receive optimum care and achieve the best health outcome possible.



Why do I need a PAL ?

Your greatest time of need is when you are least able to look after yourself.

An unexpected illness or injury can put you and your family under a good deal of emotional and practical stress.

The People's Advocate Liaison can help you avoid confusion as they are knowledgeable about our organisation, services and supports, including the wider health system.

The independent People's Advocate Liaison focusses on a situation from the client's perspective, providing support and relieving some of that stress.
